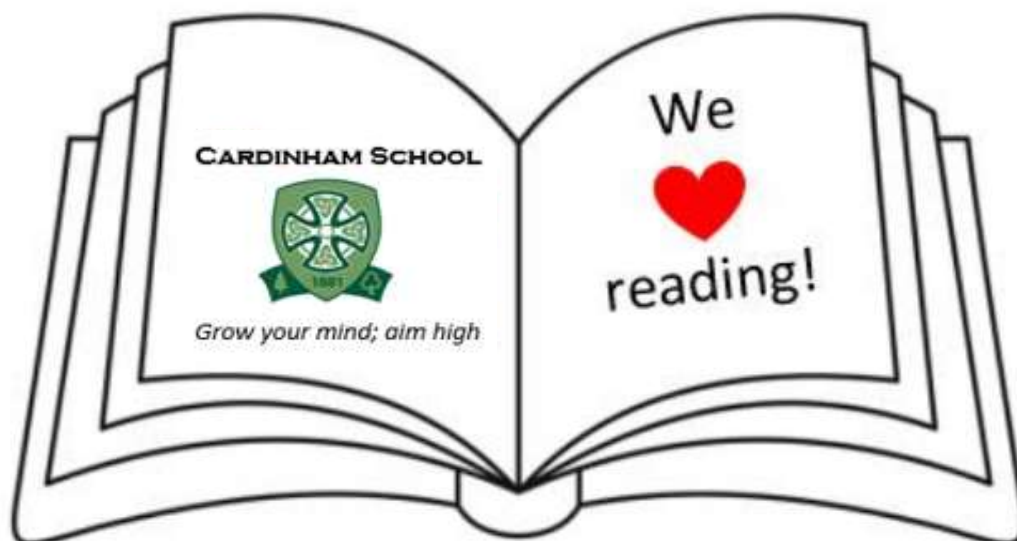

Curriculum



In Key Stage 1, our reading curriculum adapts on a yearly basis depending on the needs of the school and year group. Our timetable for the Autumn Term of the academic year 22/23 can be seen below.

- **Phonics:** All children in Year 1 and Year 2 receive a daily phonics session. As the Year 2s move through our phonics program, this session will change to a SPAG session – this is usually by the Spring Term.
- **Guided Reading:** We are committed to ensuring that every child in Key Stage 1 is heard read each day. This is either through the guided reading sessions or through 1:1 reading with either the class teacher or TA. The guided reading sessions are structured in the following way.
 - On Monday they read to decode (Text A)
 - On Tuesday they read for fluency (Text A)
 - On Wednesday they read for comprehension (Text A)
 - On Thursday, they read for decoding and fluency (Text B)
 - On Friday, the read for comprehension (Text B)

In Year 1 and 2, we develop pupils’ comprehension through the VIPERS acronym. Each letter focuses on a different skill:

- Vocabulary
- Inference
- Prediction
- Explain
- Retrieval
- Summarise

Cardinham School have developed a ‘progression of skills’ for the ‘VIPERS’ so teachers know exactly what is expected of a Year 2 as opposed to a Year 6.

Class Novel

In Key Stage 1, in addition to learning the skill of reading, we are passionate about ensuring children develop a love of reading. At 1:00pm, for 10 to 15 minutes every day, there is a chance for the class to listen to a book that they might not read by themselves.

We have found that this is the age where children start to transition for short stories to chapter books so support this transition by ensuring that the stories are all chapter books. Children in Key Stage 1 know this to be their 'Class Novel'.
